Homework

Homework books will be given out at the start of each term please send them in as you complete a task dojo points will be reward for all completed homework (for every 50 dojo points the pupils will receive a small class merit prize). Homework is important to complete and share in school for class reflection time where work will be displayed and shared with class peers.
