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Key Stage Two Weekly Spelling Lists

Introduction

This book follows on from the first book in the series 'Foundation Stage and Key Stage One Weekly Spelling Lists'. Both books provide carefully organised lists of spellings to be learned by pupils each week. If this scheme is followed from Foundation Stage to Year 6, all phonic strands and high frequency spellings will have been learned in a systematic way, using the 'Letters and Sounds Six Phase Phonic Teaching Programme' and the 'The 2014 National Curriculum'.

The spelling lists should be taught in class as part of literacy lessons (word level work). Words can be displayed using coloured felt tip marker pens in order to emphasise the various patterns. The lists may be photocopied for the children to (take home and) learn (at home) on a weekly basis. The revision lists (pages 6 - 20) have two spaces for children's individual errors which should be taken from their personal spelling logs. On all other lists (pages 22 - 56), the final two words are from the 2014 Y3/4 and Y5/6 word lists.

There are additional 'Extension' lists for the more able and gifted pupils. For the less able children, there are lists that are centred around the revision of Key Stage 1 work.

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How to Use This Book

For Children in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

1. The children should be given the relevant part of the diagnostic test on page 4 at the beginning of each term.

To help you make an initial assessment of each child's learning needs, use the following Phases of the diagnostic test for the appropriate year.

Year 3	Phases 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9
Year 4	Phases 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12
Year 5/Year 6	Phases 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16

2. If children score 7 out of 12 or more on a particular 'phase' of words they can be assumed to have secured the sounds and patterns adequately within that test.
3. Children should begin their weekly spelling work on the first phase of words where their score is lower than 7 out of 12.

Child 3a should start on Phase 6 (found on pages 20/21) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 3b should start on Phase 9 Year 3 Term 3 lists (found on pages 26/27) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 3c should now be tested on phases 10 to 15 because he/she has already secured all spelling patterns covered in Year 2 and Year 3.

Child 3d should now be tested on phases 3a and 3b. If an appropriate set of words cannot be found following that test, it may be necessary to give the child a word list from the Key Stage 1 Book.

Child 4a should start on (Phase 9) Year 3 Term 3 lists (found on pages 26/27) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 4b should start on (Phase 12) Year 4 Term 3 lists (found on pages 32/33) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 4c should now be tested on phases 13 to 16 because he/she has already secured all spelling patterns covered in Year 3 and Year 4.

Child 4d should now be tested on phases 3, 4, 5, 6. If an appropriate set of words cannot be found following that test, it may be necessary to give the child a word list from the Key Stage 1 Book.

Child 5/6a should start on Phase 13 Year 5 Term 1 lists (found on pages 34/35) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 5/6b should start on Phase 16 Year 6 Term 1 lists (found on pages 40/41) because he/she has scored less than 7 for the first time.

Child 5/6c should now move on to Year 6 Term 2 followed by Year 6 Term 3 then work through the revision lists.

Child 5/6d should now be tested on phases 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and back even further if necessary.

Teachers' Notes – Diagnostic Spelling Test

Each word below should be read out aloud, put into a sentence and then re-read by the teacher.

After listening to this, the children should then individually write down the spelling in the appropriate space on their answer sheet.

e.g. Number 1, **cat** – The **cat** was sitting by the fire – Number 1, **cat**
