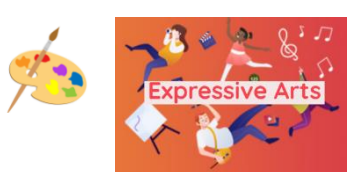

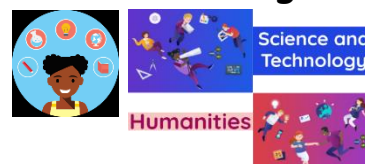

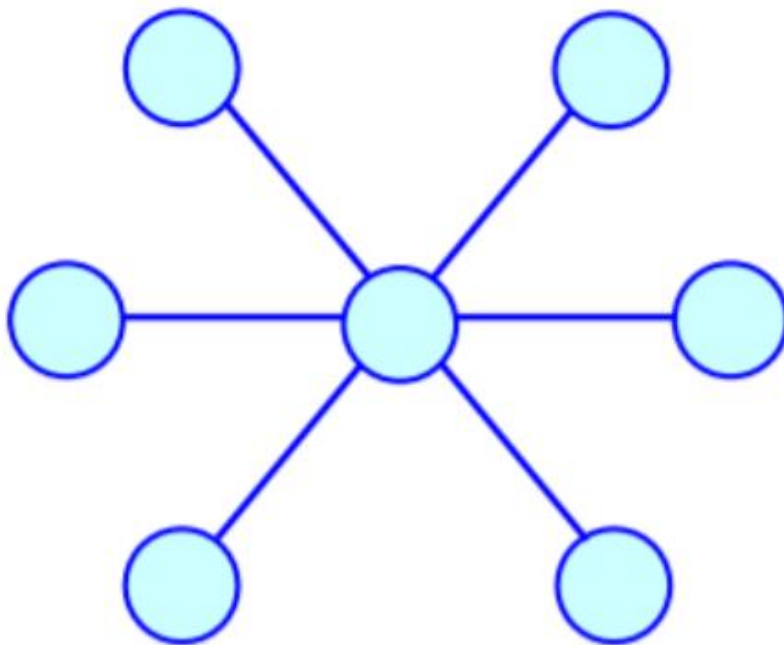

Put the numbers

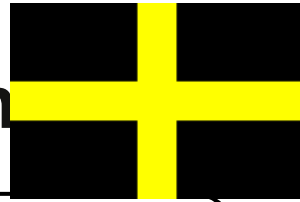
1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7

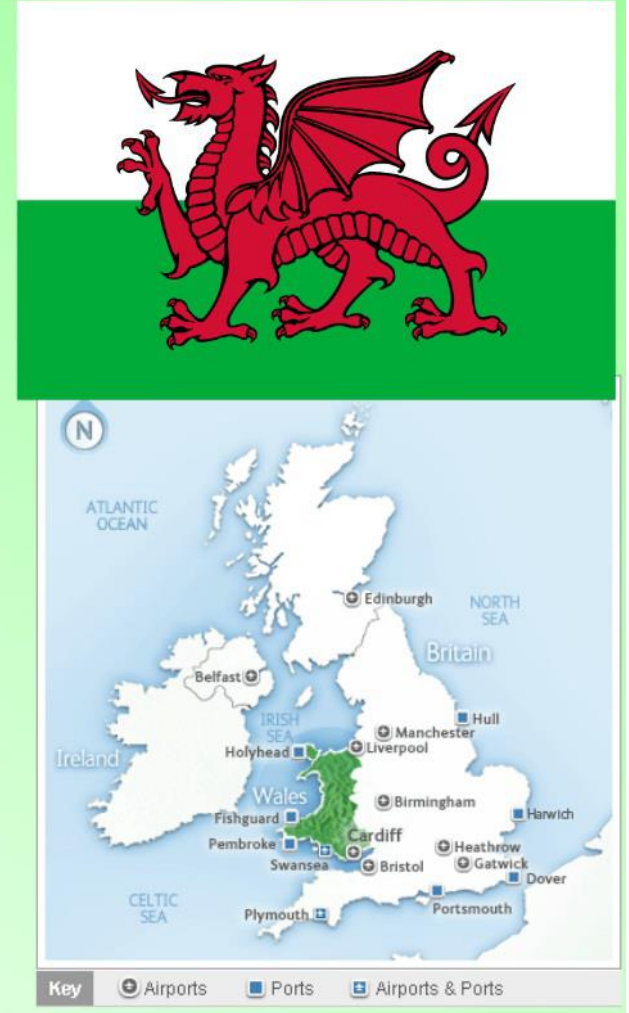


St Davids Day: Patron Saint of Wales
