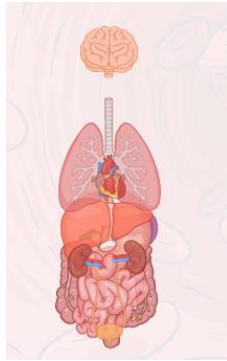


Organau'r Corff
