Dear parent or guardian

The planned vaccination session in your child's school has been postponed.

This is due to unexpected issues with the nasal spray flu vaccine supply across the UK.

Until the vaccine supply returns to planned levels again, the current stock is being prioritised for children with a long term health condition, and younger children (those aged two or three years of age on 31st August) as these children are more likely to be very unwell if they catch flu.

Flu can sometimes cause serious complications, especially in those with health conditions, so if your child has a long-term health condition, for example asthma that requires inhaled corticosteroids, a heart condition, or diabetes, it is important they get their flu vaccine so please contact your GP surgery.

We anticipate knowing more about the supply of this vaccine later this month.
