Choose one activity each week to complete in your homework book. Your book will need to be returned to school every Wednesday for the class reflection time where homework will be displayed and shared with class peers.

Mathematics and Numeracy Create top trump cards using Ancient Egyptian Gods and Goddesses.	Humanities Mark Egypt and its major landmarks on a world map. Include cities, rivers and oceans.	Science and Technology Make a 3D model of a typical home during Ancient Egyptian times.	Mathematics and Numeracy Write some maths questions or word problems to solve using Egyptian number symbols. 
Expressive Arts Research and make an Ancient Egyptian game e.g. Senet.	Humanities Research the importance of the River Nile and how it was used. 	Languages, Literacy and Communication Research the 7 wonders of the Ancient World. You could create a brochure or leaflet to present your information.	Humanities Find out some interesting facts about Ancient Egypt and create a multiple choice quiz. You could challenge your family and friends to answer them.
Languages, Literacy and Communication Write an acrostic poem using the letters of a key 'topic' word e.g. Egypt	Expressive Arts Create your own Egyptian style portrait with your name in hieroglyphs	Languages, Literacy and Communication Write 10 questions that you would ask Tutankhamun. 	Design your own homework task relating to the topic and present in your own method.
