My little sister 🧑🏻 when I won. Next, we...

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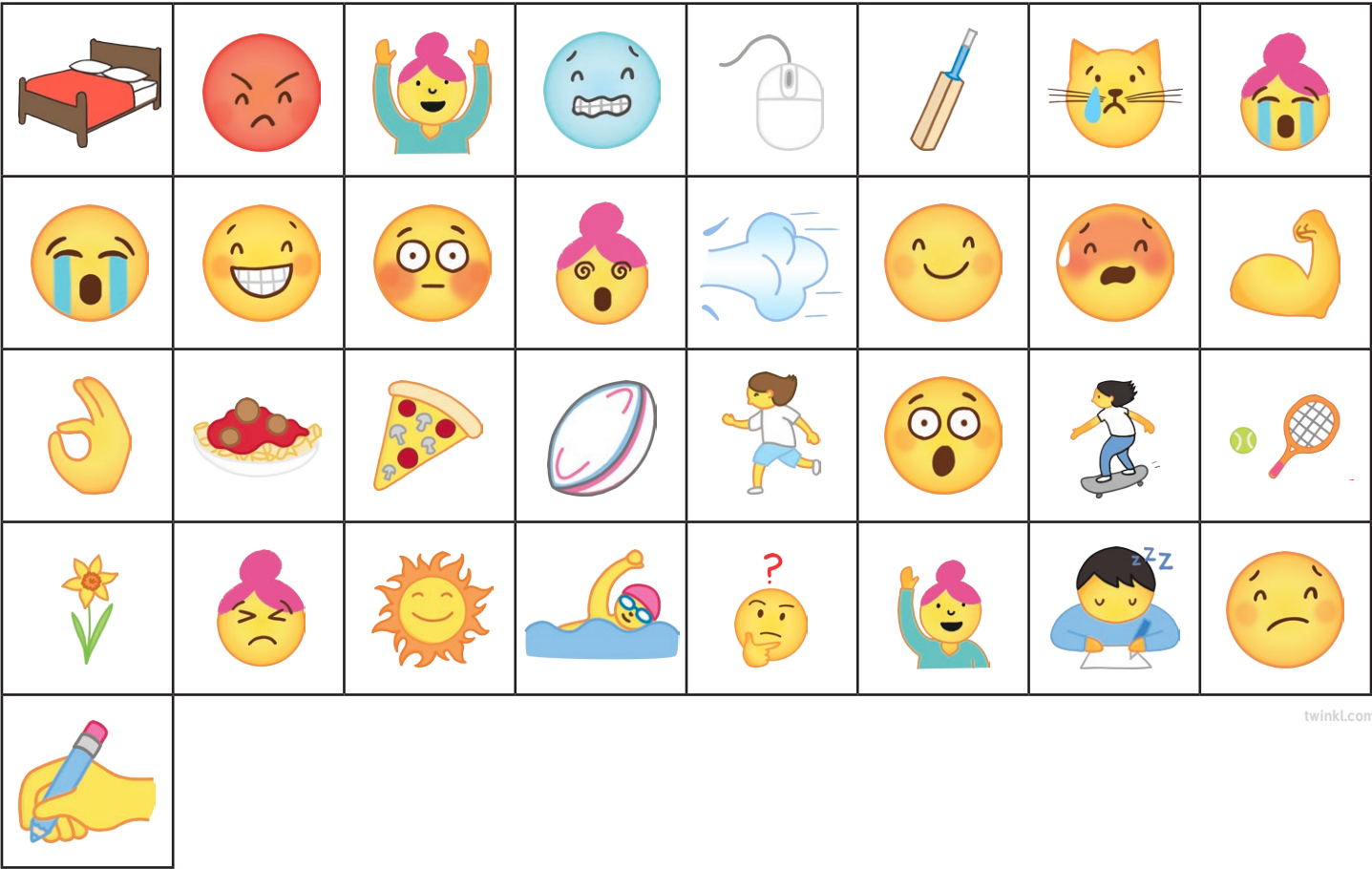

- time conjunctions, e.g. **first, then,** **meanwhile,** **after that,**
next, later, **eventually,** **finally**
- details about events, e.g. **who?** **what?** **where?** **when?** **why?**
- past tense verbs.
